Young adults engaged with Orphans and Widows of Omaha are provided opportunities to engage with the widowed and offer support with daily activities and chores. While helping a widowed person young adults are earning money to help offset their debts, these funds are matched and utilized to help young adults become debt free. These support relationships often result in long term beneficial relationships with the widowed, creating a community of multigenerational support.
